SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

Our goal is to enhance the quality of life in our community. Our supportive services will impact quality of life issues identified by our community such as access to fresh foods and grocery stores, access to medical care, and access to activities for senior citizens.

The Rising Stars Educational Enrichment Program (RSEEP) strives to develop a community of choice through excellence in education. 1. Providing a safe and nurturing environment during out of school time.
2. Providing enrichment activities that focus on reading and math.
3. Providing physical activity and nutrition education to combat obesity.
4. Offering a curriculum focusing on character development.
